The cardoon, Cynara cardunculus, also called the artichoke thistle, is a thistle in the sunflower family.



Helianthus is a genus comprising about 70 species of annual and perennial flowering plants in the daisy family Asteraceae.



Mexican Hat (Ratibida columnifera) is part of the prairie coneflowers. They are sometimes yellow, and others are brown and yellow.



Ajwain, —also known as ajowan caraway, bishop's weed, or carom—is an annual herb. They have a strong scent.



Asclepias syriaca, commonly called common milkweed, is a species of flowering plant that can grow very tall.



Colorado Tree Cholla Cactus, Opuntia imbricata, is the only shrublike cactus found in Colorado. They can live 30 years or more.



Buffalo Gourd, Cucurbita foetidissima, grows in the Southwest region on the U.S. We don't recommend eating them, they are bitter!
